





The FHLBNY is offering \$5 million in funding for the 2025 Small Business Recovery Grant (SBRG) Program to provide grants that benefit FHLBNY members' small business and non-profit relationships. Interested members should review the <a href="mailto:SBRG Program Guidelines">SBRG Program Guidelines</a> and related materials on the FHLBNY's website. Members may begin to submit their <a href="mailto:SBRG Application & Certification Form">SBRG@fhlbny.com</a> at 8:30 a.m. ET on September 15, 2025,\* until the funds are exhausted or December 1, 2025, whichever occurs first.

## **Program Funds**

Current Program Funds:	\$5 Million
Member Cap:	Maximum of \$50,000 per member
Grant Minimum:	\$2,500 minimum per eligible recipient  Grants requested below this amount will not be processed.
Grant Maximum:	\$10,000 maximum per eligible recipient  The entire requested grant amount must be passed through to the recipient.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

Eligibility will be determined by the member and the member will certify they have completed all due diligence.

- <u>Eligible Recipients</u>: Registered small businesses<sup>1</sup> and non-profit organizations<sup>2</sup> that are:
  - A verified startup or existing entity currently operating or requires the grant funds to resume operations under a reasonable plan
  - Located within the FHLBNY's District: New York, New Jersey, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands
- <u>Eligible Uses of Funds Include</u>: Funds can be used for the startup or expansion of a small business or nonprofit, including building purchase, land acquisition, construction, equipment, working capital and other related uses. A full list of eligible uses can be found in the SBRG Program Guidelines on the FHLBNY website.

# **Member Application & Certification Process**

- Member will find, qualify, and certify eligibility for up to 20 small business or non-profit recipients for an amount not to exceed the Grant Maximum.
- Members are allowed a one-time application submission, listing all eligible small businesses or non-profits, not to exceed the \$50,000 Member Cap.
- Members must certify at the time of application submission that they have complied with the requirements of the SBRG Program Guidelines.

#### **FHLBNY Review & Funds Disbursement**

- The FHLBNY will process applications received on a first-come, first-served basis and issue grant funds to the member's FHLBNY Overnight Investment Account. Any missing information must be rectified within 7 business days and resubmitted.
- Misuse of Funds and Recapture: Supporting documentation will not be collected by the FHLBNY; however, the member is required to retain supporting documentation on file. Any evidence of misuse or fraud may result in recapture directly from the member.
